Position Summary:

This position is responsible for assessing the quality of products and accurately sort them according to specified criteria. The ideal candidate will have a keen eye for detail, strong organizational skills, and the ability to work efficiently in a fast-paced environment. Some of the job functions include:

- Place products in containers according to grade and mark grades on containers.
- Weigh products or estimate their weight, visually or by feel.
- Discard inferior or defective products or foreign matter, and place acceptable products in containers for further processing.
- Grade and sort products according to factors such as color, species, length, width, appearance, feel, smell, and quality to ensure correct processing and usage.
- Record grade or identification numbers on tags or on shipping, receiving, or sales sheets.
- Separate fiber tufts between fingers to assess strength, uniformity, and cohesive quality of fibers.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Previous experience in a similar role preferred.
- Strong attention to detail and ability to maintain accuracy in grading and sorting processes.
- Good communication skills to interact with supervisors, peers, and subordinates effectively.
- Ability to perform physical tasks such as lifting, balancing, and handling materials.
