Position Summary:

The safety coordinators are responsible for planning, implementing and overseeing company's employee safety at work. Their main duty is to ensure that the company is in compliance and adheres to Occupational Safety and Health (OSHA) guidelines to reduce work-related injuries.

Some of the job functions include:

- Safety Program Development: Develop, implement, and update safety programs and policies tailored to the specific needs of the farm, including hazard identification, risk assessment, and mitigation strategies.
- Training and Education: Coordinate and conduct safety training sessions for farm workers, emphasizing safe equipment operation, chemical handling, and emergency procedures.
- Inspections and Audits: Regularly inspect farm facilities, equipment, and work areas to identify safety hazards and ensure compliance with safety regulations.
- Emergency Response: Coordinate drills to ensure all farm personnel are prepared for accidents, fires, or other emergencies.
